Needed Items (for every diaper bag)

Diaper bag (new or like new)

Changing pad

Swaddle blanket

Burp clothes

Pacifiers (0-6 months)

Safety kit (nail clippers, bulb syringe, thermometer)

Baby shampoo

Baby lotion

Diaper rash cream

Baby socks

Baby hat

Onesies (3-6 months)

Baby wash clothes

Additional Suggestions (Items that add icing on top)

Bath gel for parents

Warmer baby blanket (cloth or knitted)

Gift cards for restaurants

Lanolin nipple cream

Nursing pads

Snacks for parents

Baby toy (0-6 months)

Teething ring

Baby Bath towel
